



**Whereas;** Tangletown neighborhood and community predominantly consist of housing and households that do not reflect the racial and economic diversity of our city nor the diverse housing needs of its residents, and

**Whereas;** The Tangletown Neighborhood Association (TNA) recognized that this imbalance works against its common vision of inclusion and diversity within our community, and

**Whereas;** The TNA addressed affordable and fair housing as a significant goal within its 2017 strategic plan, and

**Whereas;** The TNA created the Equity Task Force (ETF) working group in 2020, and

**Whereas;** The Advocacy sub-working group of the ETF identified Tangletown fair housing awareness and its concerns as a priority, and

**Whereas;** Stable, quality housing at an affordable price can be a springboard for success in educational, employment and health pursuits,

**Be it resolved that** the current TNA board support efforts to build community awareness about housing injustice, past and present, and actively undoing discriminatory housing practices by promoting and preserving affordable housing within Tangletown through inclusive programs, policies, partnerships, and funding that increase the economic diversity of and access to the resources of our neighborhood.
